pioneering beach clean experts, **Nurdle**, are back in town. Whatever the weather, they'll be working hard to remove the hundreds of thousands of plastic pellets that litter our shoreline and river mouth, using their range of ingenious machines...

In January the team removed 1.2 million nurdles and biobeads from the beach and river mouth!!
