
Who's responsible for Charmouth's water courses?

The flood risk management team (LLFA) at Dorset Council regulate ordinary watercourses. The mapped ordinary watercourses are indicated on the drawing below by red lines.

There are also other natural or artificial channels above or below ground through which water flows, such as a rivers, brooks, becks, ditches, mill streams or culverts which may be considered ordinary watercourses.

Brown lines mark the location of main rivers which are regulated by the Environment Agency.
